Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA)

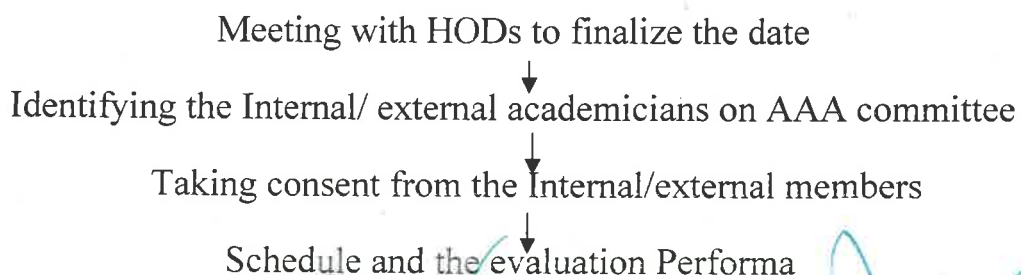
